Exhibits will be accepted on Sunday, July 19th from 2 to 4 P.M.

All articles must be the handiwork of the exhibitor.

The decision of the judges are final. Ribbons and premium money are awarded at pick-up: Blue \$4.00; Red \$3.00; White \$2.00.

Fair officials will take every precaution for the safe keeping of exhibits after their arrival, but please understand that we cannot be responsible for any damages or losses that may occur.

Exhibits can be picked up on Saturday, July 25th from 8:00 – 9:00 P.M., Sunday, July 26th from 8:00-9:00 A.M. or on Monday, July 27th, from 8:00 – 9:00 A.M.

Section 1 – Bread

- One small loaf or 2 slices of bread on a paper plate covered with plastic wrap.
- Three (3) rolls or muffins on a paper plate covered with plastic wrap.

Section 2 – Pies

1/6 slice of pie on paper plate covered with plastic wrap.

Section 3 – Cakes

Loaf and layer cakes – must be homemade. Loaf cake – one piece; Layer – one wedge –shaped piece on paper plate covered with plastic wrap.

Section 4 – Candy

Must be homemade, 6 pieces covered with plastic wrap on a paper plate.

Section 5 – Cookies

Must be homemade, 4 cookies/bars on a paper plate and covered with plastic wrap.

Section 6 – Canned Goods

Guidelines for canning:

1. Label jars (not on bottom) with contents of jar and date (please use permanent marker).
Canning must have been canned August 2025-July 2026

2. Leave bans on for transporting items to the fair, however bans must be removed when presented for judging

- Fruits
- Juices
- Meats
- Vegetables

Pickles and Relishes

Standard canning jars with vacuum-type lids must be used.

Jams, Jellies, Preserves, Marmalades, and Misc.

- **Butters** -fruit pulp cooked to semi-solid state.
- **Jams** -Almost holds its shape, but not jelly-firm. Made from crushed or ground fruit.
- **Jellies** -clear jellied fruit juice.
- **Marmalades** -jelly with small pieces of citrus fruit distributed throughout.
- **Preserves** -whole fruits or large pieces of fruit in a thick syrup, slightly jellied

Section 10 – Paper Crafts

- Greeting
- Rubber Stamp Art
- Quilling
- Origami
- Papier Mache
- Hand Made Paper
- Scrapbooking (3 or more pages)

Section 11 – Amateur Photography

- Photo sizes 4x6 or 5x7 and can be in color or black and white.
- All must be in simple black frames.
- Composition and exposure must be the work of the exhibitor.
- Judging will be done by the usual standards of subject matter, composition, and photographic excellence.

Section 12 – Flowers

Exhibitors must furnish all containers. Plants should be groomed (remove dirt, dead foliage, and dead flowers).

- **Display** – a group of 5 to 10 blooms to create an attractive arrangement.
- **Potted plants.**
- **Single Specimen** – Single bloom, cluster, spike or spray.
- **Arrangement** – Consists of all fresh plant materials. Container/display base will also be judged.
